We need your help with the Dinners and Jams. We need folks to help set up the tables, chairs, put out the flowers and place mats.

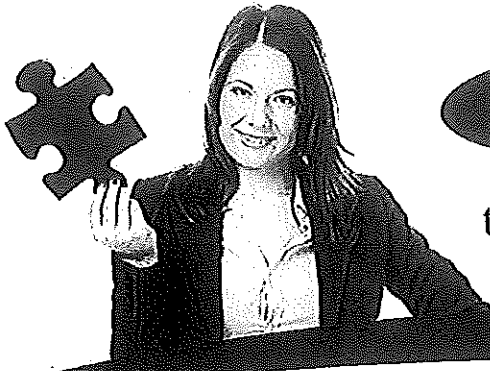

Whatever time you have to give we will appreciate it and value it. It does not have to be for the whole night maybe you can only give an hour of your time.

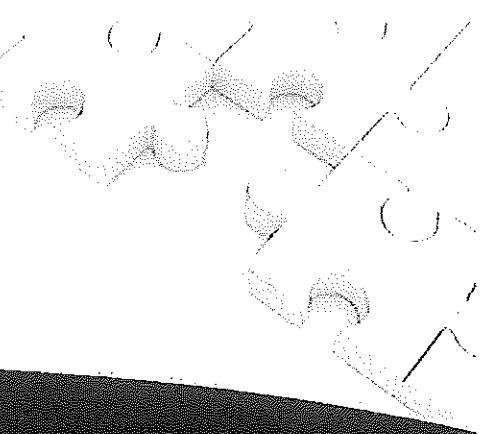

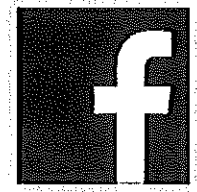

MINUTES OF THE REGULAR MEETING TUESDAY DECEMBER 13, 2016

The final regular meeting of Council for this year was held this date at the Calvin Community Centre. Present were Mayor Brown, Deputy Mayor Pennell, Coun Adams, Coun Edwards, Coun O'Connor, Chris Whalley, Ken Brewitt and Lynda Kovacs.

The meeting was called to order at 7:00 p.m. by Mayor Brown

PECUNIARY/CONFLICT OF INTEREST: None Declared

PRESENTATIONS/DELEGATIONS: Dexture Sarrazin – Re: Proposed Mattawa Splash Pad, Not-for-Profit organization to create safe social active spaces. Location is Timmins Park Mattawa. Sponsorship package being developed to distribute to area municipalities, local groups, businesses and individuals. Dexture to share resolution being considered by Town of Mattawa Council with Calvin Clerk-Treasurer in the near future. Hoping to be “shovel ready” spring 2017.
Presentation completed at 7:25 p.m.

Kevin Grant – Re: Stewart’s Road Expressed dissatisfaction with: a) Council’s decision not to assume Stewart’s Road for year round maintenance since there are year round residents on that road; b) the passing of By-law No. 2016-020 in three readings at one Council meeting; c) Closed Council Meetings to which he is 100% opposed; d) the requirement for upgrade to Stewart’s Road to be classed as year round – feels that no upgrades are necessary and that the Municipality should simply just plow the road as is done for other taxpayers; e) that the Grant family is being discriminated against; and, f) that Mr. Grant’s feelings on this issue are supported by many others. Mr. Grant indicated that he was not seeking comment/response from Council on his presentation and none was given.

2016-184 OPT FOR COMPLETE OFFICIAL PLAN REVIEW
Moved by Coun O’Connor and seconded by Coun Pennell that Council supports the East Nipissing Planning Board and recognizes the potential cost savings in opting to undertake a *complete review* of the current official Plan (OP) at this time, which would then not need to be reviewed for ten (10) years as per Bill 73, rather than an *update* to the OP which would then be required to be reviewed in five (5) years’ time.

2016-186 DECLARE SURPLUS OF BREATHING APPARATUS AND APPROVE ORDER OF NEW UNITS
Moved by Coun O’Connor and seconded by Coun Pennell that Council hereby approves the request of the Fire Chief under Section 4.3.2 of Procurement By-law No. 2004-022 from calling for Formal Quotations for six (6) breathing apparatus (SCBA), as only one supplier has been identified for the preferred product;
And further that the six (6) new SCBA’s be ordered in January 2017 and that the funds be taken from Fire Department Reserves for this purchase and included in the 2017 budget;

And further that once the new SCBA's have been delivered the current six (6) MSA SCBA's be hereby declared surplus to the needs of the Municipality and are approved for sale by the Fire Chief and that all monies generated from the sale of those SCBA's, along with the credit to be received from MSA in January 2017, shall be returned to the Fire Department Reserve in 2017 and reflected in the final 2017 budget.
