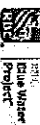

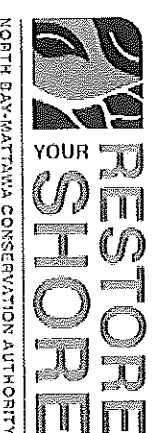

Enhance Your Shoreline!

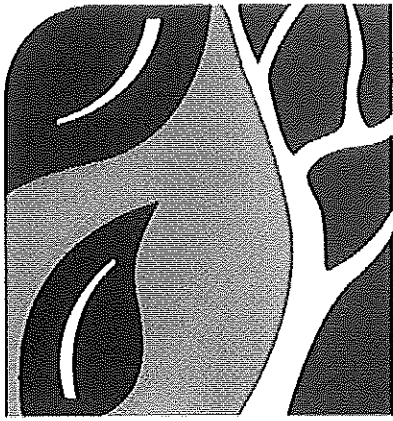

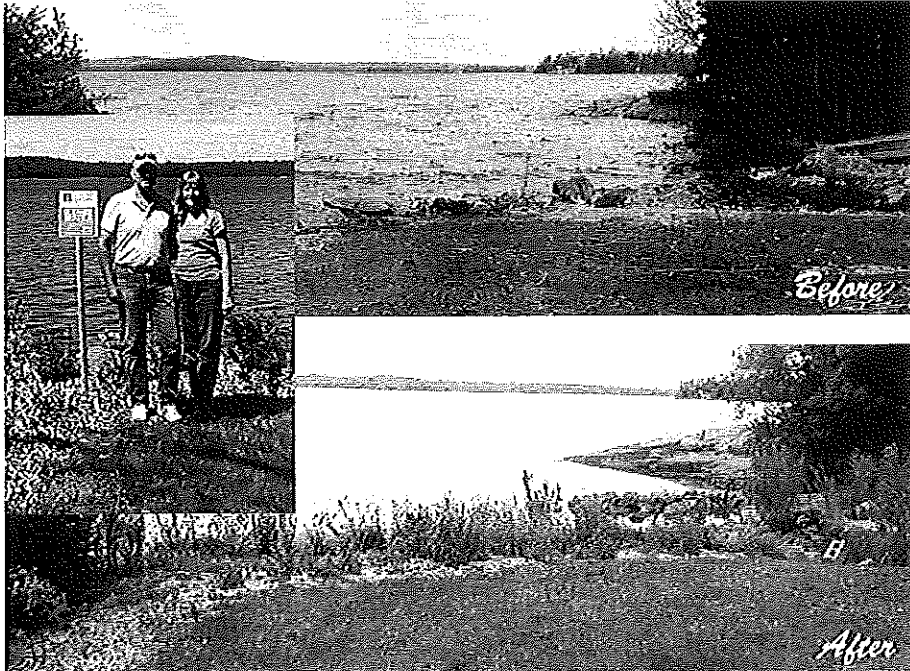

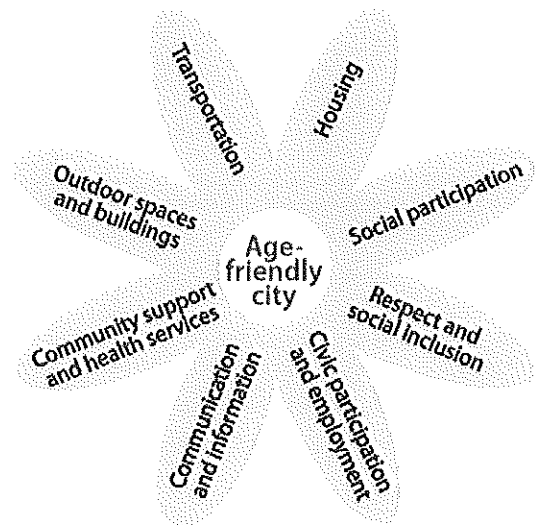

2017-078 CONSENT APPLICATION #2017-04 CONC 2 LOT 25 TO CREATE 2 ACRE RESIDENTIAL LOT

Moved by Coun Pennell and seconded by Coun O'Connor – WHEREAS an application for Consent No. 2017-04 in the name of Bell/Gauthier has been filed with the East Nipissing Planning Board on lands known as Concession 2 Lot 25, Municipality of Calvin, to create one (1) new residential lot of approximately 2 acres, which is located on a year round maintained municipal road, and;

WHEREAS the North Bay Mattawa Conservation Authority has provided Minimum Distance Separation (MDS) from nearby livestock facilities, and; WHEREAS entrance to the proposed residential lot from the easterly direction does not allow for required visibility but has been pre-approved for clearance by the Public Works Superintendent subject to #2 below;
NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Municipality of Calvin RESOLVES that:

1. It is recommended that the East Nipissing Planning Board give provisional consent to this application, and;
2. That the proposed lot has limited visibility for entrance from the easterly direction. The Public Works Superintendent must be contacted for entrance permit and for locate of entrance on proposed lot and suggests 30 km/hr. advisory speed sign to be posed by the Municipality.
3. A copy of the completed survey for the new residential lot shall be

provided to the municipality, in both hard copy and digital format, and;

4. That the 5% Cash In Lieu shall apply to the newly created lot and is payable in full to the Municipality as a requirement of consent.
