DID YOU KNOW THAT?

You can vote if you are:

*A Canadian citizen

*At least 18 years of age; and

*Live in the Municipality of Calvin or own or rent property in the Municipality of Calvin or are the spouse of a person who owns or rents property in the Municipality of Calvin.

Are YOU on the Voter's List?

The voter's List is available at the Clerk's office at 1355 Peddlers Dr. during regular office hours from September 3/18 through to October 22/18 (Monday to Friday 8:30 am to 4:00 pm). You may check the list at this location up until Election Day. You may also call (705-744-2700) or email the Clerk's office (clerk@calvintownship.ca) and we will check the list for you. Please note that we will ONLY look up your own information. Anyone being added to the Voter's List will be required to provide proof of Canadian Citizenship, either when they submit their application to be added to the Voter's List or at the voting place on Election Day or at the Advance Poll.

ALL voters WILL be asked for identification prior to obtaining a ballot.

If your name *IS* on the Voter's List, you will simply be asked for proof that you are the person named on the list (e.g. driver's license, health card, library card – showing name, address and signature).

If your name *IS NOT* on the Voter's List, you will be asked for proof of identity (as stated above) **PLUS** proof of Canadian citizenship (e.g. birth certificate, passport, Canadian citizenship card).

YOU will need to SHOW IDENTIFICATION to the Election Official AT THE VOTING PLACE.

- ONE PIECE SHOWING YOUR NAME, ADDRESS AND YOUR SIGNATURE

OR

- TWO PIECES OF IDENTIFICATION; ONE SHOWING YOUR NAME AND YOUR SIGNATURE AND THE SECOND SHOWING YOUR NAME AND ADDRESS

EFFECTIVE IMMEDIATELY

The Municipality of Calvin has recently entered into a contract agreement with the Township of Papineau-Cameron and the Municipality of Mattawan for Shared Building Services. Effective immediately, Mr. Shane Conrad has been appointed as Chief Building Official/Building Inspector for all three Municipalities. Mr. Conrad brings many years of building and contracting experience to this position and is considered to be a valuable asset to our local communities.

For all of your building needs Mr. Conrad will initially be available in the Calvin Municipal Office 1 day per week (day to be determined) and/or on an as needed basis. It is the goal of the Municipality to ensure that the building department needs of our community continue to be met as efficiently and as cost effectively as possible.

Attention Dog Owners

Due to the higher than usual number of dog related complaints this past month, I would like to remind residents that all dogs must be tagged. Dog owners shall register each dog they own with the Municipality. Tags must be securely fixed to the dog at all times. The dog tag expires upon the death of the dog or the transfer of the dog to another municipality.

Tags are **free of charge** and are not transferrable. In the event that a tag is lost or destroyed, the owner of the dog may obtain a replacement tag **free of charge**.

Tags are available at the Municipal office during regular office hours (Monday-Friday from 8:30am to 4pm).

All dogs shall be kept under restraint at **all times** and not permitted to be off the premise or property unless **under the control** of a competent person. No dog shall be permitted to run at large at any time.
