Whereas, the Board of Management also has an ongoing responsibility to all of the member municipalities, each of which would be materially affected by the Proposed Restructuring:

Whereas, the Board of Management is required to carefully consider the facts and details in relation to major transactions and no facts or details have been provided for the Proposed Restructuring:

Whereas, the MLTC must provide its prior approval of the Proposed Restructuring or any change in composition and ownership of Cassellholme which requires an amendment to the Long-Term Care regulation pertaining to Cassellholme;

Whereas there has been no public consultation by any party concerned, regarding such a transition

The Board resolves to investigate the Proposed Restructuring which process shall include but not be limited to:

- Obtaining the details of and rationale for the Proposed Restructuring from the City of North Bay:
- A fulsome community consultation process which will include defining expectations as they relate to performance, care, compliance, financial sensibility, and the interests of all stakeholders;
- · Commissioning of the redevelopment of Cassellholme; and,
- Considering the effects of the Proposed Transaction on all relevant factors including the personal safety of, well-being
 of, and quality of care received by, residents of Cassellholme.

The Board commits to working constructively with the City of North Bay to provide relevant and helpful information towards the potential change from a District to a Municipal Long-Term Care Home.
