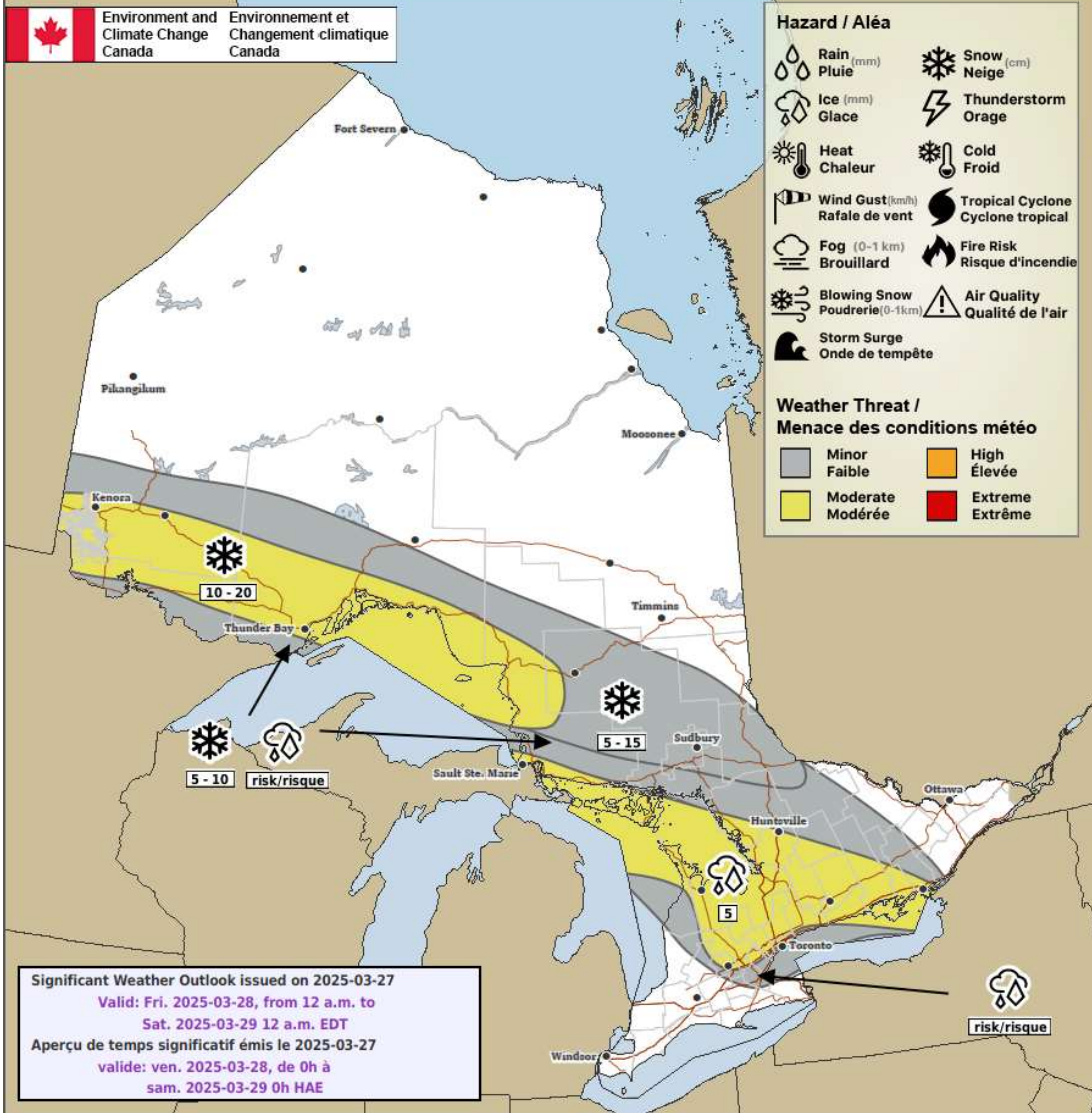

<p>A prolonged and significant freezing rain event is expected to begin on Friday evening when the first of multiple waves of freezing rain moves in. There remains some uncertainty with how far north and east the area of freezing rain will extend. Freezing rain is expected to continue into the weekend for portions of southern, central, eastern and northeastern Ontario.</p>

<p>Snow will begin in northwestern Ontario before dawn Friday morning and in northeastern Ontario late Friday morning or early afternoon. Snow will be heavy at times through the day. Snow is expected to pull out of northwestern Ontario Friday evening, however areas in northeastern Ontario will see snow through the weekend.</p>
