1. This request for quotation is due on March 27th, 2026, at 1:00 p.m.
2. Prices quoted shall be per liter for 35% Calcium Chloride, supplied and applied as per OPSS 506.
3. The bidder's truck shall accurately control the application rate and will be applied in a single application.
4. Bidders shall be able to accommodate the request to apply within one week of request.
5. All delivery costs shall be included in the unit price. The Municipality shall take ownership of the product upon delivery completion.
6. Samples may be taken by the Public Works Superintendent or designate for testing purposes.

STANDARD CLAUSES

The following clauses shall form part of this request for quotation.

1. Liability Insurance

The Contractor shall take out and keep in force until the date of acceptance of the entire work by the municipality, a comprehensive policy of public liability and property damage insurance acceptable to the Municipality providing insurance coverage in respect of any one accident to the limit of at least \$5,000,000.00 (five million dollars), exclusive of interest and cost against loss or damage to property and such policy shall name the Municipality of Calvin as an additional insured thereunder and shall protect the Municipality of Calvin against all claims for all damage or injury including death to any person or persons and for damage to any property of the Municipality of any other public or private property resulting from or arising out of any act or omission on the part of the Contractor or any of its servants or agents during the execution of the contract and the Contractor shall forward a certified copy of the policy or certificate thereof to the municipality before the work has commenced.



2. Protection of Existing Works

The contractor shall ensure that no damage is caused to any existing works. The Contractor shall be responsible for all damage claims which are alleged to be due to the work performed under this contract or order.

3. Contractor's Risk

The contractor shall assume full responsibility as to the public safety, public liability and property damage, and their employees performing the work shall be covered by the Contractor's WSIB. In addition, work will conform to the requirements of the Occupational Health and Safety Act, and regulations under this Act.

4. No Interference to Council

No bidder, nor contractor, nor associate to the bidder or family member will have influence with the Council on the decision of the request for quotation. Any contact with a member of Council, or influence of a member of Council shall deem the bid null and void and will remove future bids from the contractor.
